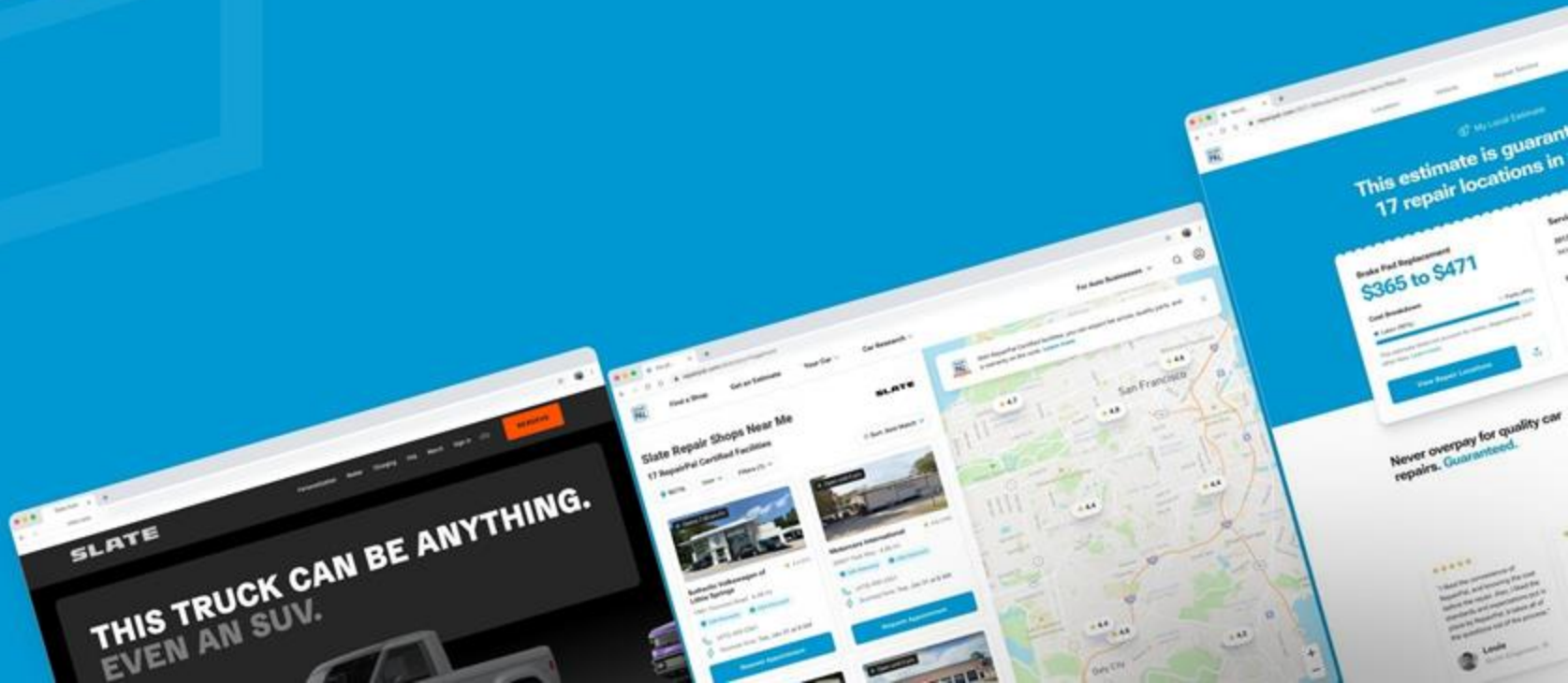

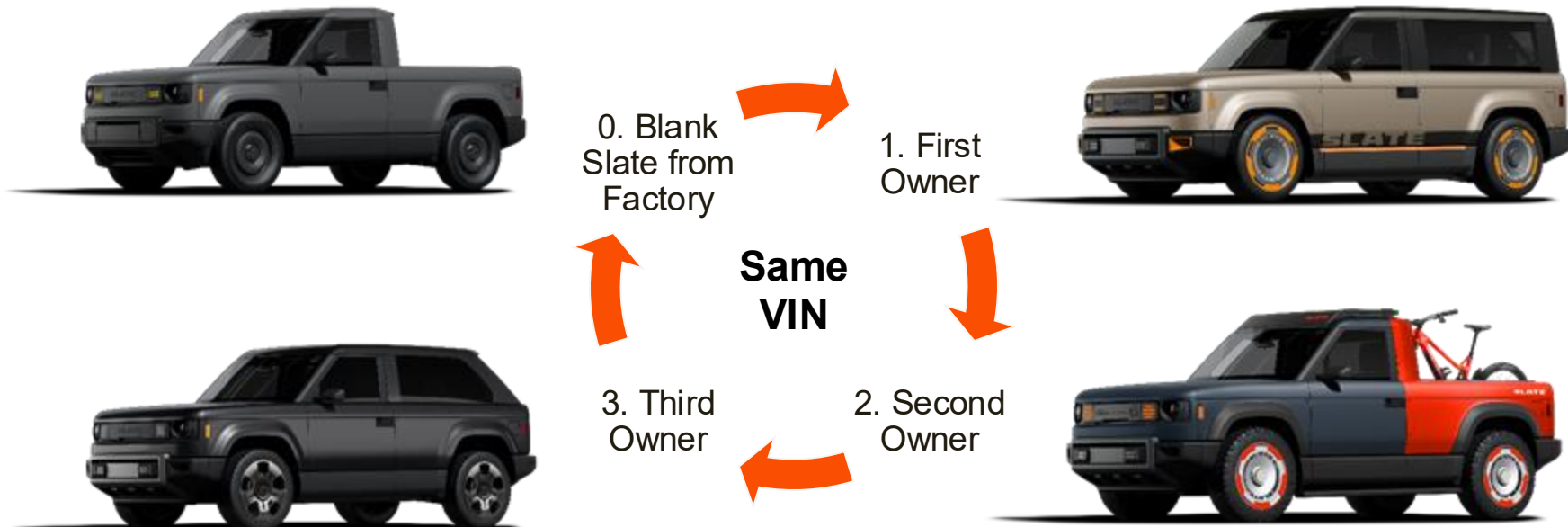

RepairPal Certified Slate Network

Warranty, service repair, and accessory installation

RepairPal will support the Certification and Onboarding of shops into the Slate network.

Once you're Certified, you will be able to work on OEM vehicles, with three levels of certification:

- High Voltage (HV)
- Low Voltage (LV)
- Accessory upfit

Slate will provide additional training through *Slate University*, to ensure that Certified centers have the required knowledge to successfully assist our customers.



Slate Participation Categories

Warranty, service repair, and accessory installation

RepairPal will verify your tools, equipment and training to determine eligibility for the three service categories (Accessory installation, Low Voltage repair, High Voltage repair).

- You can participate in whichever segment of repair you choose
- Example: your shop can choose to only do Slate accessory installation, and you can receive valuable “Do it for me” (DIFM) work like SUV Conversion kits or vinyl wrapping (if your shop does that)
- If qualified, you can also choose to only perform repairs, whether it is low voltage or high voltage or both.

Your participation plan is a blank Slate!



Slate Requirements

Low Voltage Certification

- Safety equipment required by your state or local government
- Example: Gloves, eye protection, steel toe shoes, hearing protection.

LV special tool requirements

- Digital scan tool, insulated hand tools
- Level 2 charging capability (240V) on site (not required but highly recommended)

Training

- General understanding of EVs and HV basic training.
- ASE or equivalent training on EVs, Hybrid, Plug-In Hybrids
- **OR** OEM equivalent training (Ford, GM, Stellantis, VW, Tesla, Rivian, Lucid or similar) on basics of EVs.
- Low voltage familiarity with 12V systems (air bag, sensors, seat belt sensors, ignition, etc.)



Slate Requirements

High Voltage Certification

Certification & Technician Requirements

- Top-tier EV certification required
- Technician must have ASE or equivalent, plus completed industry-standard HV training per local government requirements (e.g., OSHA)

Safety Equipment (as required by state/local government)

- Insulated gloves, face shield, hard hat
- Hearing protection, fireproof/retardant long-sleeve jacket or shirt
- Work boots, safety hook
- Lock Out/Tag Out device (prevent unplanned system activation)
- Floor signage and HV warning signs to mark boundaries



Slate Requirements

High Voltage Certification (Continued)

HV Special Tool Requirements

- Insulated hand tools (rated up to 1,000 volts)
- Digital ohm meter (e.g., Fluke 1587, 1,000V rated)
- Battery lift table or equivalent

Charging On Site (not req'd at this time, but highly, highly recommended)

- Level 2 charging (240V), Level 3 charging optional/preferred for shop/customer use

Training

- ASE or equivalent HV battery training required
- xEV Safety Certifications by ASE (Level 2 High-Voltage Vehicle Technician)
- OEM HV training (e.g., Ford, GM, Stellantis, VW, Tesla, Rivian, Lucid)
- Slate-specific HV training (battery, drive motor, HV systems: HVAC, charging, power distribution, etc.)

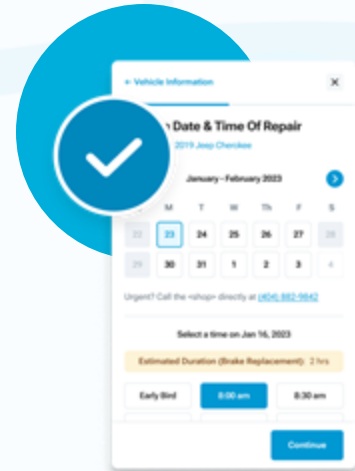
